SIL are a small but well run company, in Ludhiana, Punjab, manufacturing threaded rods and sprung channel nuts for the construction industry. The facility is wholly owned and is controlled by Mr Kapoor (Managing Director). A visit was made by BBCL on 8th November 2006.

The company is highly responsive and have several export customers across Europe and the USA.

The company also offers tie rods, foundation bolts, threaded hooks and similar for the construction industry as well as a range of fasteners. Fasteners are produced off site.

The facility is small and of an older style. Ventilation and lighting is adequate and emissions are within local requirements. Plans exist for upgrades to the facility and machine tools but management focus is currently on achieving ISO 9001 certification.

Inspection is 100% at each stage of production

Packaging is to customer quantity requirements in export quality cloth wrap or cardboard tubing and shipped on pallets.

Quotations are available for FoB or CIF. There are no minimum order requirements but pricing is higher for orders less than 20" container loads.

Total capacity is 3,000 tons per annum - 1,500 tons each for imperial & metric
This equates to approximately 8 full container loads per month although additional capacity is available through sub-contract.

Threaded bars are available in several steel alloys in standard lengths, diameters and threads; either right or left handed. All bars to DIN 975/976.

Hot dip galvanisation (HDP) is performed on site. Finishes include Zinc, Cadmium and Tin plating and blue, gold, white, green and black colour.

Bars in additional materials are available on request.
